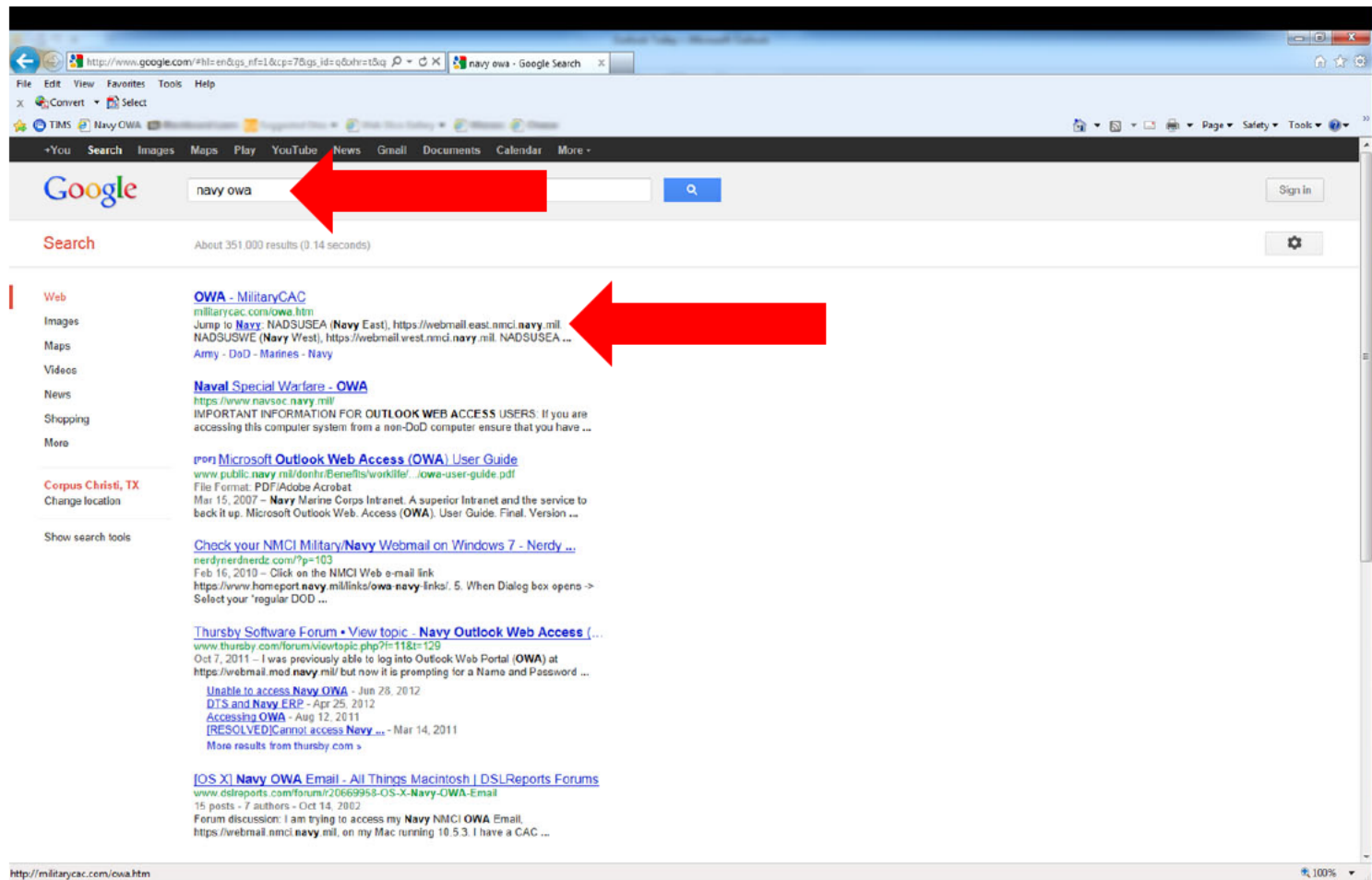

OWA

(Outlook Web Access)

- Your military email address
- Requires a CAC card reader
- Use Internet Explorer (unless you are really good)
- Use “E-MAIL” certificate

- Google “navy owa”
- Select “OWA – MilitaryCAC”

STEPS TO ACCESSING OUTLOOK WEB APP (2010) and OUTLOOK WEB ACCESS (2003)

Disclaimer: I've had some people concerned over having this information here for the world to see. Here are my thoughts: These are all public facing OWA servers that are sitting in a DMZ ([Demilitarized Zone](#)) on the government computer network. They all require a CAC to access so, the links won't help anyone if they don't have a CAC and an email account on that particular network.

Remember, accessing OWA requires the steps below and an email account on that network

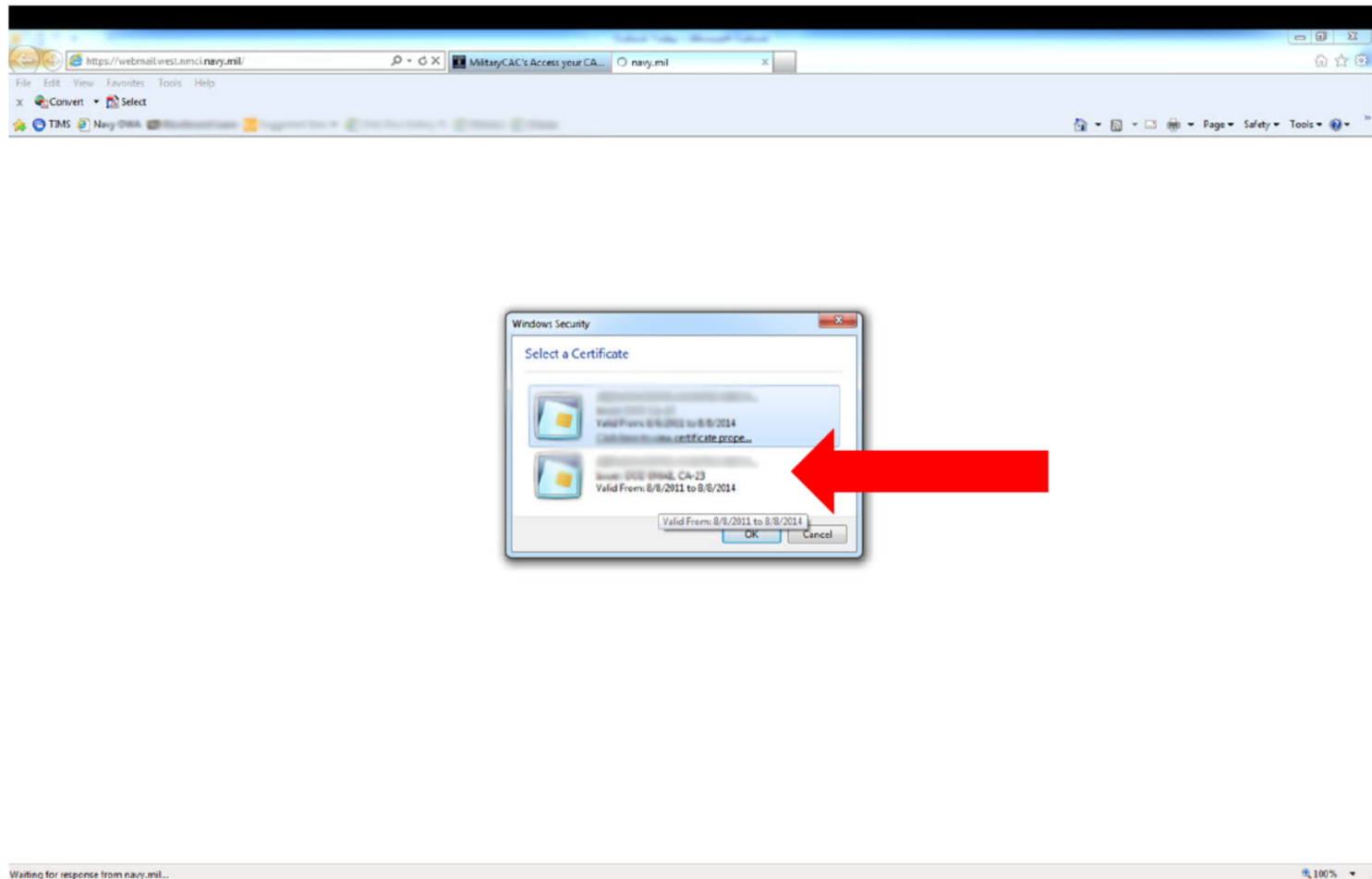

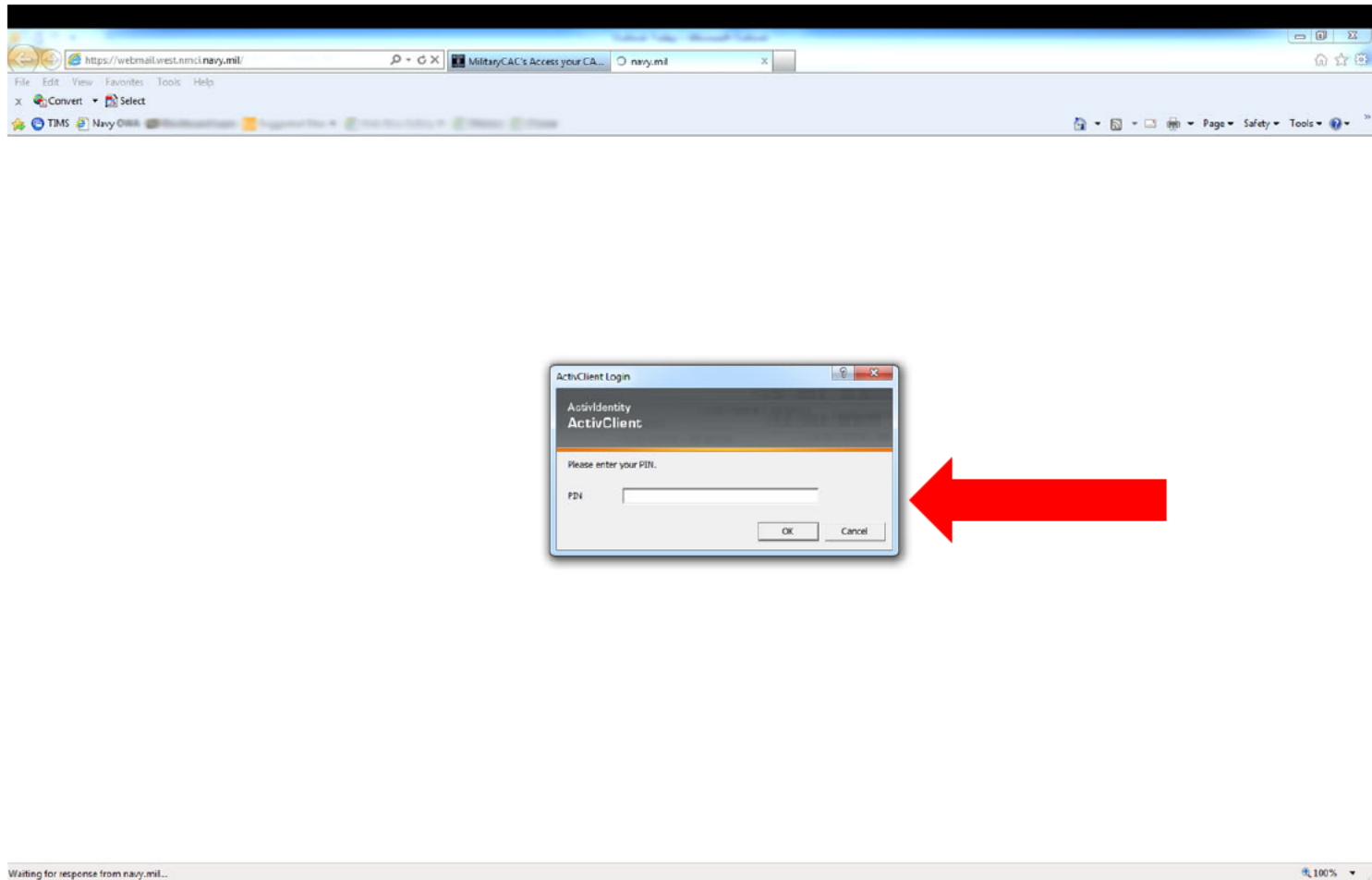
